About the Company

Since 1938, <u>Prairie Farms</u>, which is comprised of more than 750 farm families, have been producing and selling high quality products throughout the Midwestern and Southern US. According to *Dairy Foods Magazine*, the company is ranked in the top fifteen of all Dairy producers in the U.S. The firm has revenue of approximately \$3.5 billion, utilizes nearly fifty manufacturing plants, and employs more than 7,500 associates. Prairie Farms produces a wide range of products including fresh, and UHT milk, cottage cheese, sour cream, ice cream, coffee beverages, iced teas and juices, and an assortment of cheeses.

As a cooperative supported by family farms, the company is dedicated to sustainability, the communities in which it serves, and embodies a "family values" work culture.

Position Overview

Reporting to the *Vice President of Operations*, we seek a progressive and engaging leader who will encourage employees in continuous improvement activities with high-touch involvement in manufacturing principles at the Battle Creek, MI plant. This facility is unique in that it produces UHT and fresh milk and is one of the largest plants within the network of nearly fifty plants operated by Prairie Farms. Specific responsibilities include:

- Lead and provide oversight of manufacturing, sales, supply chain, transportation, procurement, and demand planning.
- Champion a strong safety culture.
- Develop and budget the management of Battle Creek's operations activities.
- Drive capital planning with budgeted dollars and meeting deadlines.
- Ensure operational KPI's including safety, quality, cost, and productivity are in place, properly monitored, and being met at the facility.
- Interface with local and regional authorities and agencies to maintain and/or establish strategies in support of compliance with required standards (safety, regulatory, environmental, etc.)
- Develop the Operations organization within Battle Creek; including organizational design, hiring, recruitment, retention of employees and succession planning. Ensure that the adequate level of training is available to all associates.
- Support the implementation of a multi-year network strategy aimed at improving produced quality and reducing production costs.

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Other important parameters for this position include:

- The position is based in Battle Creek, MI.
- The plant employees 250 associates, with 10-15 direct reports, running 24/7.
- Expect travel to be no more than 10%.
