Sororities and fraternities at Cornell encourage academic success, develop leadership skills, promote community service, and offer a chance to make lasting friendships. Their umbrella organizations – the Interfraternity Council, the Multicultural Greek Letter Council, and the Panhellenic Association – oversee nearly 70 chapters, whose memberships make up nearly 30 percent of the student population. Each chapter is encouraged to have a faculty advisor and engage faculty in student-led programs.
