Courses and custom-run programs are available to students, faculty, staff, and alumni. COE is increasingly working with faculty to help build classroom community and effective team learners, as well as to provide a laboratory for group dynamics, the natural world, and leadership development. The program also rents a wide variety of outdoor gear, 15-passenger vans, and its yurts (great classrooms just 5 miles off campus up on Mt.
