

## 2017 George D. Levy Faculty Award

### **Nomination deadline is March 31, 2017.**

The George D. Levy Faculty Award recognizes a Cornell University faculty member of any rank whose collaborative efforts within the community have resulted in exemplary and sustained community-engaged projects. The \$5,000 award supports a faculty member whose organization's programs and activities best demonstrate:

- Shared/collaborative decision-making that incorporates community voice into the design, implementation and evaluation of the project
- Community capacity building
- Integrating engaged student learning outcomes into course design and delivery
- Planning for sustaining the community partnership

The Office of Engagement Initiatives will announce the recipient of the 2017 prize at the [Community Engagement Showcase](#), April 24, 5-7 p.m.

Candidates for this award may be self-nominated or nominated by others.

### **Submission Package Checklist**

- A cover letter, no longer than two-pages, that includes:
  1. a description of the faculty member's involvement in a specified community-engaged partnership and how that partnership demonstrates the criteria above
  2. demonstration of reciprocity and mutuality in the community-based partnership; and
  3. an explanation of how the faculty member will use the award money to deepen, sustain or strengthen the community partnership.
- CV of faculty nominee
- Website or other material of the community partner(s), stating the public purpose of the partnership.
