



## VENATION

<p><b>Arcuate</b> secondary veins bending toward apex</p>	<p><b>Cross-Venulate</b> small veins connecting secondary veins</p>	<p><b>Dichotomous</b> veins branching symmetrically in pairs</p>
<p><b>Longitudinal</b> veins aligned mostly along long axis of leaf</p>	<p><b>Palmate</b> several primary veins diverging from a point</p>	<p><b>Parallel</b> veins arranged axially, not intersecting</p>
<p><b>Pinnate</b> secondary veins paired oppositely</p>	<p><b>Reticulate</b> smaller veins forming a network</p>	<p><b>Rotate</b> in petate leaves, veins radiating</p>
