# **Cover Crop Seed Sources for NYC Gardeners**

### **Tips on Sourcing Cover Crop Seed**

- For guidance selecting appropriate cover crops and planting dates for your area and management goals, consult the book *Managing Cover Crops Profitably*, available on-line for free at: <a href="http://www.sare.org/Learning-Center/Books/Managing-Cover-Crops-Profitably-3rd-Edition">http://www.sare.org/Learning-Center/Books/Managing-Cover-Crops-Profitably-3rd-Edition</a>.
- Try to source disease-resistant varieties (e.g., Esker oats, Aroostock winter rye, etc.).
- Make sure to source untreated seed (i.e., seed that does NOT have fungicide on it). This will ensure that it's safe to handle, and will protect beneficial fungi in your soil, such as mycorrhizae.
- Order in early spring, even for late summer or fall plantings. Some winter-kill cover crops, such as oats, are also planted in early spring as grain or cover crops. If you wait until mid-summer, you may have difficulty finding the varieties you want.
- Make sure you have enough row cover to protect newly planted seeds until they germinate...
  otherwise, you may just be buying birdseed!






