By 2024, NYS **farm brewery licenses** will require businesses to use at least 90% of NYS-grown hops and at least 90% of their other ingredients (other than water) by volume grown in New York.

To obtain a **farm distillery license** in New York State, 75% of ingredients by volume must be sourced from NYS farms.
